

NAFLD ranges from simple steatosis (NAFL) to NASH, a progressive form of liver disease^{1,2}

NAFLD: non-alcoholic fatty liver disease

NAFL: non-alcoholic fatty liver

- Steatosis (> 5% hepatic fat)

NASH: non-alcoholic steatohepatitis

- Steatosis
- Ballooning
- Inflammation

NASH with fibrosis^{3,4}

- **NASH (steatosis, ballooning, inflammation)**
- **Mild (F1):** fibrosis stage 1
- **Significant (F2/F3):** fibrosis stages 2 and 3
- **Cirrhosis (F4):** fibrosis stage 4

NAFL is generally benign, whereas NASH can progress to cirrhosis, liver failure and liver cancer^{1,2}
